Hi everyone,

Well the weather has finally warmed up (a lot), and with the heat we have to make sure we are prepared. Be sure to carry extra water, maybe some sunscreen, maybe a cooling vest or a dew rag. Do what you can to stay cool in the saddle!.

Ride 365 is off to a great start for our chapter with 15 members reporting over 68,000 miles already this year. For 2022 Ride 365 came up with these stats, H.O.G. Members Rode 25% More Miles in 2022.

The miles have been ridden and H.O.G.'s 2022 Chapter and Annual Mileage Challenge winners have been announced (see the March newsletter for results). While the winners are savoring their victories, the data reveals some interesting stats about the riding habits of H.O.G. members. Most impressively, H.O.G. members rode nearly 90 million miles last year, an increase of 25 percent in total mileage compared to 2021.

Another fascinating stat is that members who belong to a H.O.G. Chapter ride an average of 4,400 miles per year, which is about 1,000 miles more than non-Chapter members. This showcases the excellent job officers like you are doing to motivate members to ride more often and providing them great opportunities to do it.

Less impressively, many thousands of members failed to record a second mileage reading after entering the mileage program, thereby not receiving credit for the miles they rode last year in either the Annual or Chapter Challenge. Make sure your members get credit for all those miles they ride this year by encouraging them to enroll in the Ride 365 program and to have regular mileage readings recorded throughout the year.

2022 H.O.G. Mileage Program by the Numbers:

- 88,682,859: Total Miles ridden by H.O.G. members
- 576: Number of Chapters that participated in the Chapter Mileage Challenge
- 3,381: Average Miles ridden per H.O.G. Member (non-Chapter affiliated)
- 4,402: Average Miles ridden per H.O.G. Chapter Member (up 16 percent vs. 2021)

And as always, HOG pay's you to ride!

17. Motorcycle shop = 25 points
18. A sign that starts with the 1st letter in your username = 25 points
19. Graffiti/graffiti mural, it can be on a wall/post/trashcan/etc. = 25 points
20. Red sports car = 25 points
21. You in your underwear or someone in their underwear be very creative!!!! = 25 points
22. Beach or body of water = 25 point
23. Fire Hydrant = 25 points
24. Man with a straw hat = 25 point
25. Police officer/Firefighter = 25 point

To receive more points, Your motorcycle must be in the picture and/or yourself in FULL RIDING GEAR (whatever your riding gear is, helmet, jacket, gloves) with the item on the list.

Example: #1 A lighter = 20 points—Your bike with the lighter = 10extra points(30)
If you're in the picture with your bike with riding gear & the lighter = 40 points total.

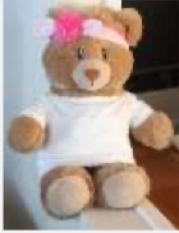

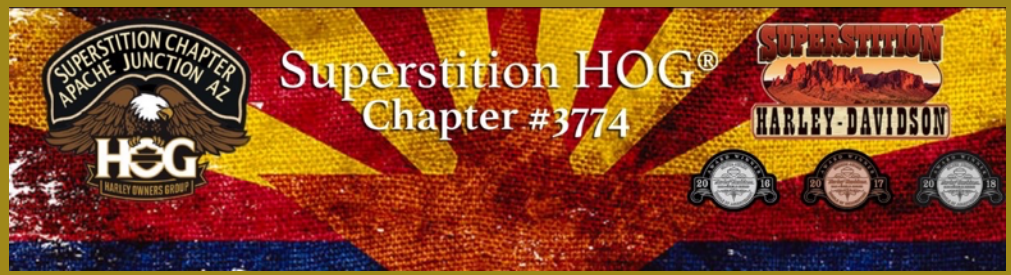
